

# TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION

## NATURAL FIBRE FINISH WALLCOVERING

<b>Design</b>	Absinth and Jive
<b>Description</b>	Commercial quality non-woven cellulose/polyester fibre wallcovering
<b>Weight</b>	89 grammes per square metre
<b>Roll Size</b>	53cm x 10m
<b>Fire Rating</b>	EuroClass B
<b>Adhesive</b>	Tekfix 65
<b>Hanging</b>	Apply adhesive to wall surface. Carefully smooth wallcovering onto wall surface using a spatula or felt roller. Butt join. Absinth and Jive have an offset match, and a 32 vertical pattern repeat. Do not reverse hang.
<b>Maintenance</b>	<p>Natural fibre wallcoverings offer a wipeable easy-clean finish with medium resistance to knocks and scrapes. With regular cleaning they will retain their original appearance for 3-5 years depending on area of use.</p> <p>Always carry out a trial in an inconspicuous area first to ensure cleaning agent is suitable. Clean with a mild non-soapy detergent with soft cloth or sponge. Do not use polishes, abrasive cleaning agents, or strong active solvent cleaners as they will damage the surface. Always clean from the skirting level upwards. Rinse thoroughly with clean water (avoid over-wetting). Individual stains should be removed as quickly as possible.</p>
<b>Health &amp; Safety</b>	This product is classified as non-hazardous and therefore does not require any special handling. This product does not require special labelling.
<b>Handling/Storage</b>	Store at ambient temperatures away from heat source. Suitable lifting equipment may be required.
<b>Fire Fighting</b>	Any extinguishing media are suitable. Wear self contained breathing apparatus, protective clothing and full face mask. Fumes should be ventilated immediately due to possible liberation of noxious gases.
<b>Ecological</b>	This product is not bio-degradable. Dispose of in accordance with Local Authority regulations or via an authorised contractor.
